3 STEPS TO FINISH PREPARATION

- Download and print the GivFree Africa Volunteer project ID Card and "TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN" document to be delivered to your preferred or choice school you mentioned or listed in the Group.
- 2. Approach the School for the 1st time (maybe) to **introduce yourself**, the **GivTree2School project** and **hand over** the "TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN" document to the **most appropriate** office or person.
 - **Note**: You will need to remind the school of the need to get immediate feedback/reply via an SMS or WhatsApp that MUST hit or drop into GivFree Africa's message box.
- 3. Preparation to Set up **GivTree School Club**:
 - Arrange and agree on the date & time to meet the rest of 2 Volunteers (if any), 2 teachers (to be nominated as club masters plus School Head as Patron and PTA officials as Grand Patrons), and take photos and send to WhatsApp group as a sign and evidence of conclusion.

The 1st 20 schools to get to this stage, will be reimbursed with N50,000 support grants from GivFree Africa.

Finally, this is the stage we will create a page for every school on the GivFree Africa website for subsequent updates and progress reports.
